**Qualification:**

MBBS with P.G. Degree in Community Medicine from recognized University.

**Eligibility:**

Age limit: Upper age limit for eligibility will be 40 years as on the date of notification. Relaxable for SC/ST candidates by 5 years and for OBC candidates by 3 years respectively. OBC category candidates are required to submit their certificate issued by the Notified/ competent Authority Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

**Emoluments:**

Rs. 67700/- in Pay Level-11 in the Pay Matrix as per 7<sup>th</sup> CPC (Pre-revised- PB-3, Rs. 15600-39100 with Grade Pay of Rs. 6600/- P.M.). Plus usual allowances as admissible under the rules.

**How to Apply:**

The eligible and desirous candidates fulfilling educational qualifications/eligibility conditions should appear for Walk –in –interview with their application along with original certificates and one set of attested photocopy of the relevant documents in support of Age, Qualification, Attempts, Mark Sheet, Degree, DMC registration, Category & Experience Certificate etc. No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates. In case of any legal dispute the jurisdiction of court will be Delhi/New Delhi.
